## <u> Pray & Train</u>


Saturday, March 30<sup>th</sup> 4:00 – 5:00 pm

We ask that you join our team as we pray over our Easter Services, see the space at Buddy Holly Hall, discuss logistics for Sunday, get additional instruction from your team lead, and ask questions.



- Be on time for your shift.
- Be on the look out for a text next week from your team leader with more details about your scheduled time.
- 7:00 AM ARRIVAL TIME: Worship and Production Team, Kids Ministry Production Team, and Kids Care Team park in the north lot on the back side of the BHH. \*Please DO NOT park in the section labeled as Staff Parking (this is for the Buddy Holly Hall Staff only). Enter through the back door.
- 7:45 AM ARRIVAL TIME OR LATER: All other volunteers or Kids Care Team members, please park in the back of the west lot or further out in the main lot next to the Civic Center on the South side of the BHH. \*Wherever you park, please leave the front spaces for our

- guests (same way we serve our faith family on Sunday mornings).
- Pick up your lanyard at the Connection Point before your shift and return to the Connection Point at the end of your shift.
- Parking Lot Team pick up your vests at the West entrance from your team leader, Ricky Salas.
- Ushers pick up your hand-held radios at the Coffee Bar from your team leader, Jordan Lee.
- Know the layout: Nursery and Kids areas, Connection Point, Volunteer Check In/Lanyard Pick Up, Lost and Found (at the Connection Point), Bathrooms (downstairs) –

- Nursery is for 6 weeks to 3 yrs. old; Kids is for 4 yrs. old through 5<sup>th</sup> grade.
- If someone wants to be saved, wants to join a community group, would like prayer, or needs assistance direct them to the Connection Point.
- If someone has lost something send them to the Connection Point
- Staff members will be strategically posted around the building and will be available to assist you if needed. They will be wearing a teal colored lanyard.
- If there is an emergency, please notify the nearest staff member first and they

- will notify LPD and/or the EMT if necessary.
- There will be no saving seats in the auditorium. If guests save seats, we ask that you kindly say, ""Apologies, but we kindly ask that seats not be saved. Thank you for your understanding." If the guest asks why. Please respond with, "We want to accommodate all guests equally. By not saving seats, we aim to create a welcoming environment where everyone has an equal opportunity to find seating."
